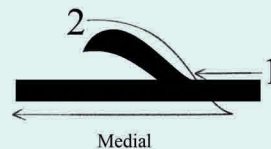
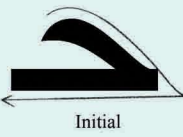

No. 6 - "ḥā"

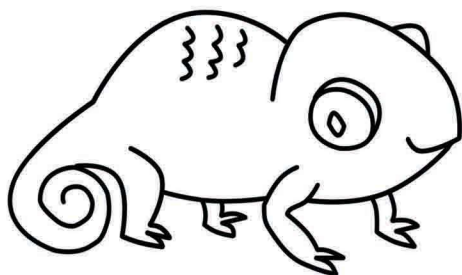
