No. 1 - "alif"

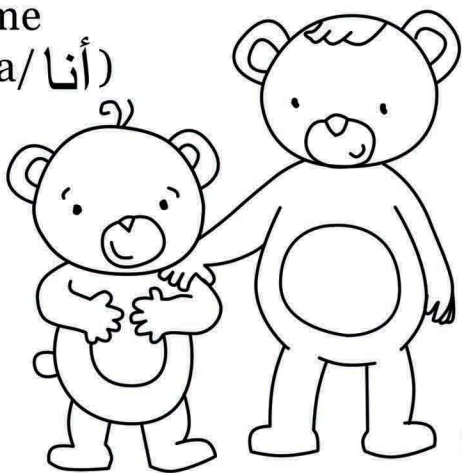

When it doesn't, we make the same sound, but hold it longer.

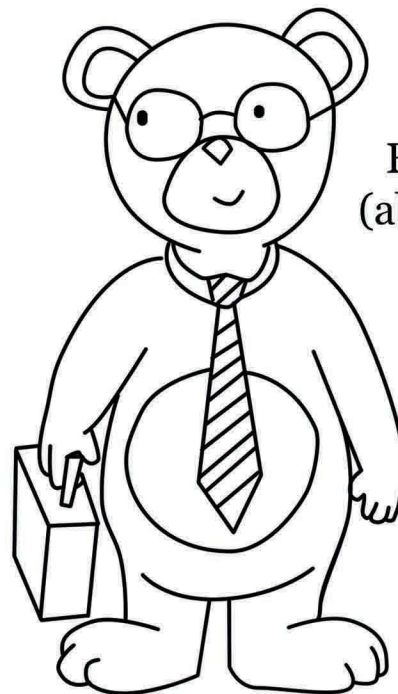
