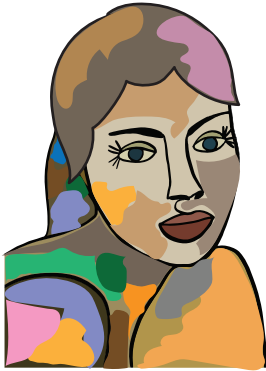
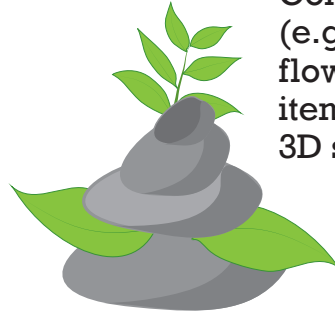


Art Activity Choice Board

Create a self-portrait collage using pictures from magazines or newspapers.

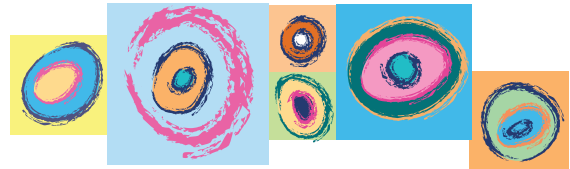


Collect items from nature (e.g., sticks, leaves, rocks, flowers). Then use these items to create a 3D sculpture.

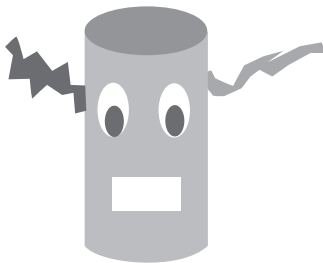
Create your own comic strip using ideas from another subject area (e.g., math, science, or ELA).



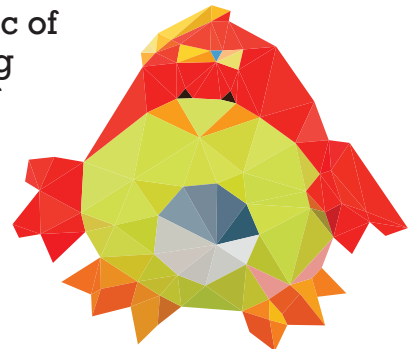
Recreate a famous piece of art by creating your own version of it. Use your own personal style.
