#### Author's Purpose **Sort It Out!**

#### **Teacher Directions:**

- 1. Cut out the sample text cards below (there are 30 total).
- 2. Hand out one card to each student.
- 3. Hang the three *Author's Purpose* signs in three corners of the room and instruct students to stand near the author's purpose that matches up with their card.
- 4. Collect the cards, mix them up, and repeat.

#### Alternative Activities:

- Hold up one of the *Author's Purpose* cards and ask students to give examples of places they've seen that type of text in real life (i.e., billboards, commercials, textbooks).
- Have students work independently or with a group to sort the entire set of cards into three groups, based on the three types of author's purpose.
- Play a scoot game! Mix up the cards and number them. Then, place the text cards around the room. Have students use a notebook and walk around the room, identifying the author's purpose for each piece of text and writing down their (numbered) answers for each card.
