Authors have three main purposes for writing:

1. **Persuade.** The author wants you to believe or do something.
2. **Inform.** The author wants to tell or teach you something.
3. **Entertain.** The author wants to tell you a story that you will enjoy.

Remember the word **PIE!** It is a trick to remember the three main reasons why authors write text.
