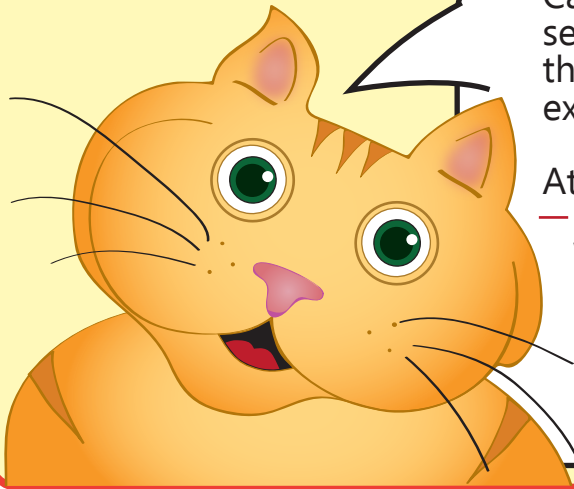


# Learning about Capital Letters



Capital letters are used at the beginning of a sentence. They are also used at the beginning of the name of a person or a place. Here is an example:

When writing letters, you must use capital letters at the beginning of the greeting as well as the closing.
