## Change an Adjective → to an Adverb

An **adjective** is a word that modifies or describes a noun. Many adjectives can be turned into adverbs by adding the suffix **-ly** to the end.

**Example:** sad → **sadly**

If the adjective ends in a consonant then **y**, change the **y** to an **i** before adding **-ly**.

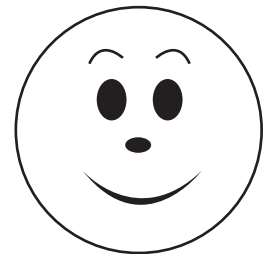
**Example:** happy → **happily**

If an adjective ends in a vowel and then an **l**, keep the **l** and add an additional **-ly**.

**Example:** beautiful → **beautifully**

## Change an Adjective → to a Noun

An **adjective** is a word that modifies or describes a noun. Some adjectives can be turned into nouns by adding the suffix **-ness** to the end.

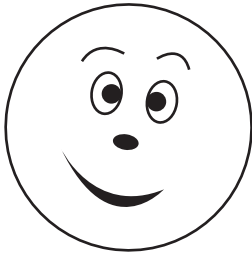
**Example:** sad → **sadness**

If the adjective ends in **y**, change the **y** to an **i** before adding **-ness**.

**Example:** happy → **happiness**

This suffix does not work with all adjectives, so make sure to check the dictionary if you're not sure about a word in your own writing.
