Habitat: tropical rainforests, dry woodland savannas, and grasslands of central Africa

Size: males 5½ feet tall, 100-130 pounds; females 4½ feet tall, 80-110 pounds

Lifespan: 30-60 years

Eats: fruit, flowers, insects, mammals, leaves, seeds, birds, and some human food
