
Animal Classes

Vertebrates are animals with a backbone. Can you guess what an invertebrate is?



Birds

These warm-blooded animals lay eggs and have feathers.

Fish

Fish are cold-blooded animals that live in the water. They have scales, fins, and gills.

Reptiles

These cold-blooded animals usually lay eggs and have scaly skin.

Mammals

Mammals are warmblooded animals that produce milk to feed their young. Most mammals have hair on their body.

Amphibians

These animals can live both on land and in water. They have moist, smooth skin.

Arthropods

These animals have an exoskeleton, segmented bodies, and jointed limbs.
