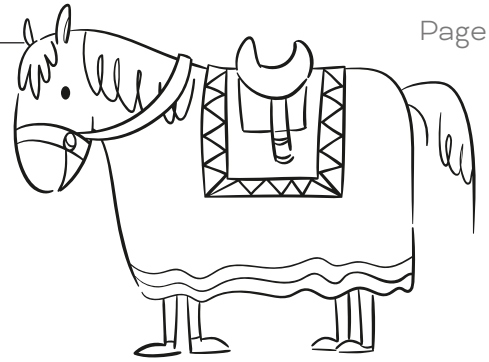


## Nouns, Verbs, and Adjectives: Common Prefixes and Their Meanings

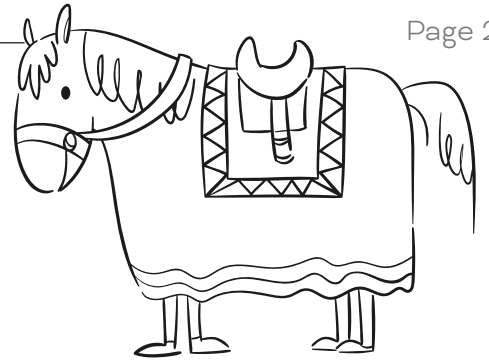

com-, con-	with	<i>companion,</i>
de-	off, away from	<i>contradict,</i>
en-	put into	<i>enclose,</i>
ex-	out of, former	<i>ex-president,</i>
extra-	beyond, more than	<i>extracurricular,</i>
hyper-	over, more	<i>hyperactive,</i>

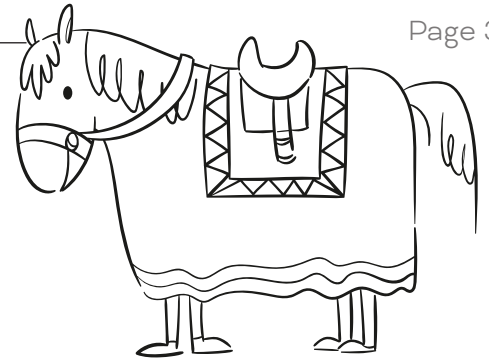

pre-, pro-	before, forward	precede, project,
sub-	under	submarine,
syn-	same time	synchronize,
trans-	across	transmit,
tri-	three	tricycle,
