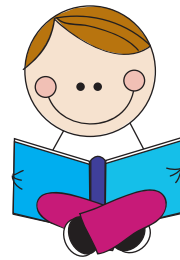
Good writers always use **complete sentences**.

Complete Sentences

- Share a complete thought.
- Use many details.
- Tell us **who** did **what** and **where**.
- Use capitalization and ending mark rules.

- Do **NOT** share a complete thought.
- Do **NOT** use details.
- Do **NOT** use capitalization and ending mark rules.
