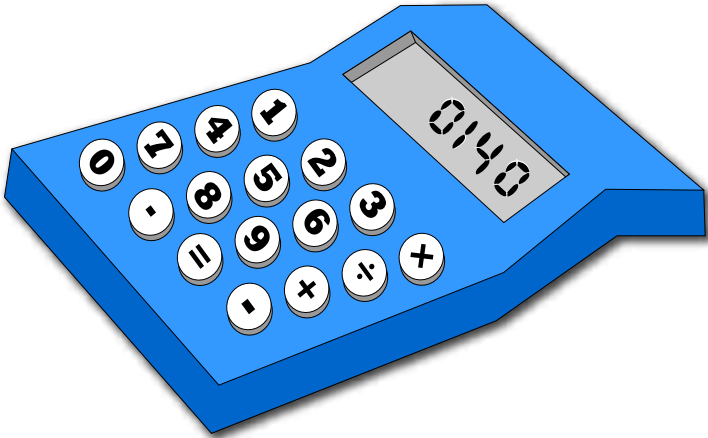


Complete the Mystery
