A **comparative adjective** compares two nouns. There are some rules for turning adjectives into comparative adjectives.

1. Add -er to a one syllable word. (Sometin the final consonant!) Big → Bigger Mean → Meaner	mes it is necessary to double
2. Add -r to a one syllable word ending w Large → Larger	ith an "e"
 If a two syllable word ends with a "y", ch Funny → Funnier 	hange it to "i" and add -er .
4. For words with more than two syllables, use the word " more " or , " less " before the adjective. Do not add the -er suffix.
