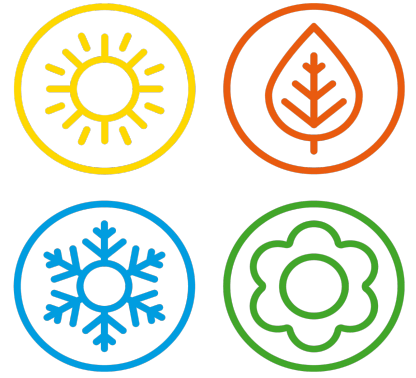


Correct Spelling Errors in Sentences: Seasons
