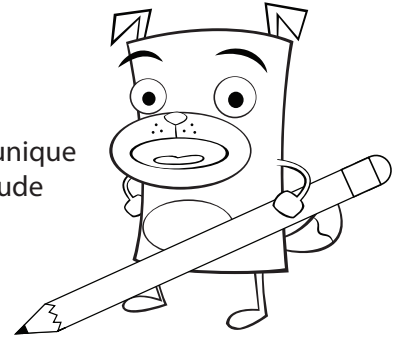

Crafting Imagery

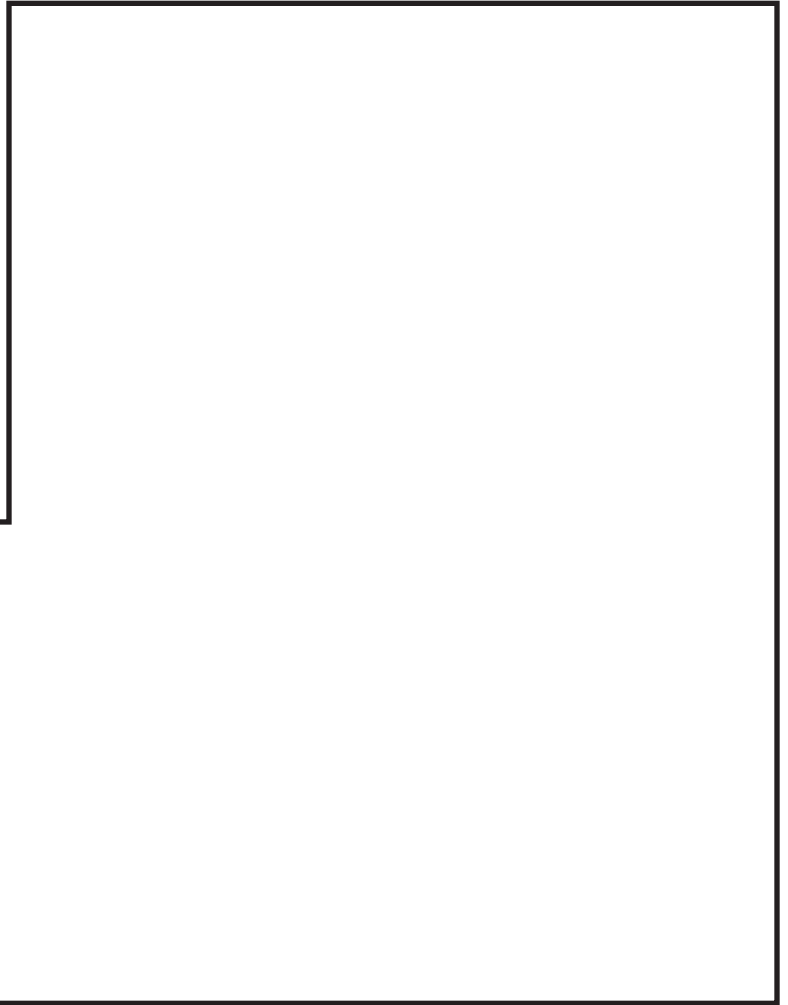
