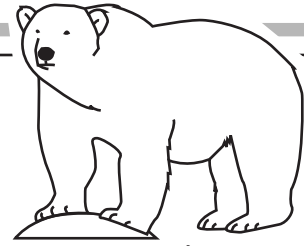


Develop an Opinion About a Nonfiction Topic
