The Day of the Dead

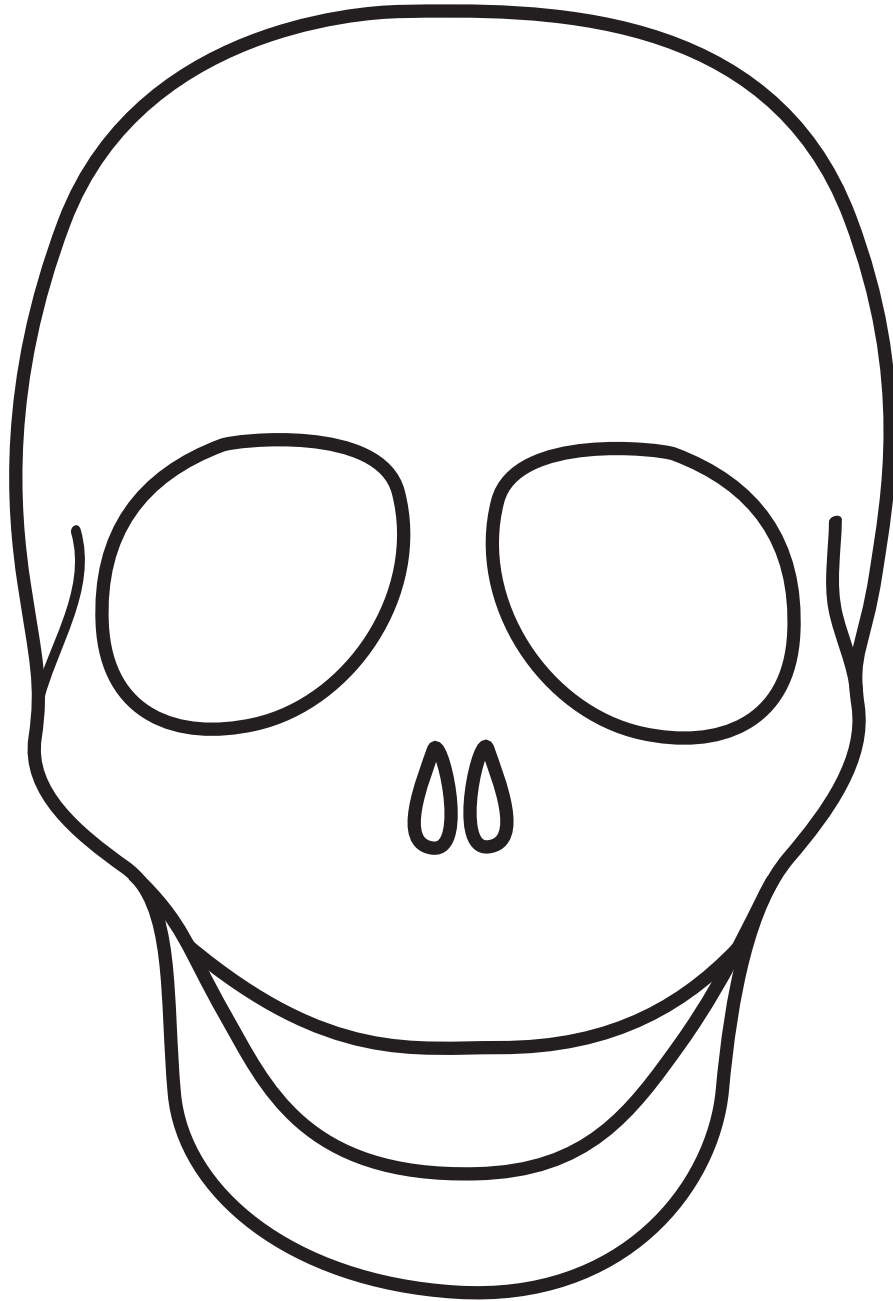
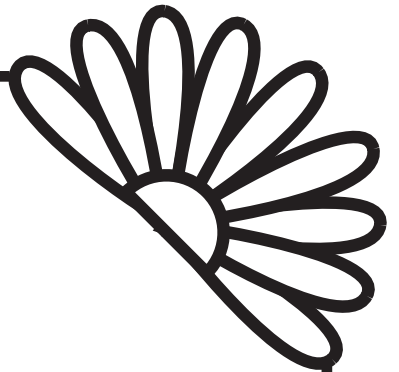

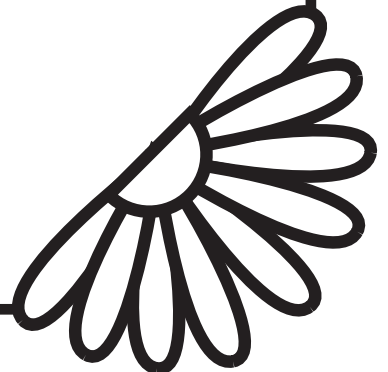
Families and friends often decorate altars for their loved ones with skeletons, favorite foods, candles, and flowers.
