

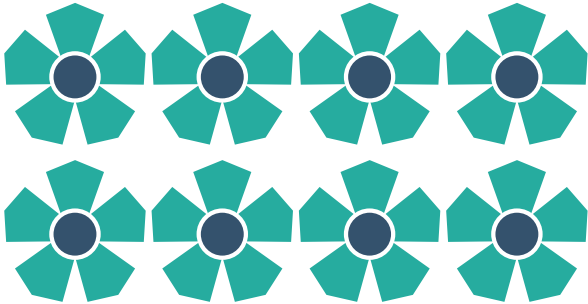

Equal Groups: Division 2



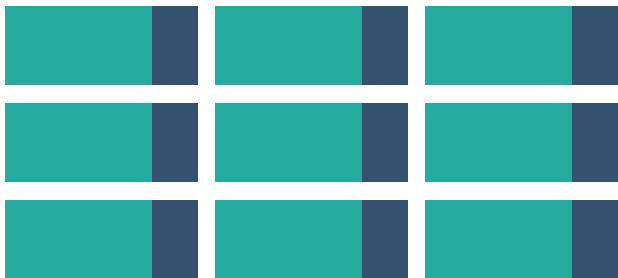
Directions: Make equal groups. Then write a division sentence for each picture and solve.

There are 8 flowers. Make groups of 4.



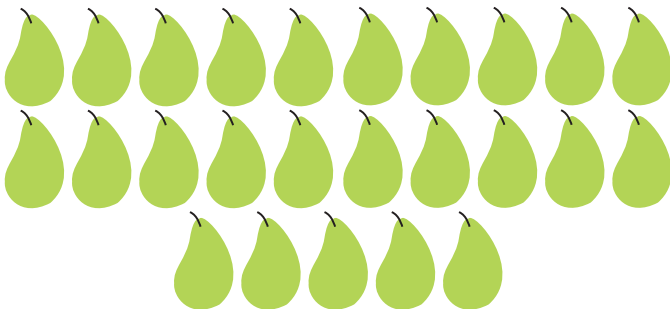

There are 25 pears. Make groups of 5.



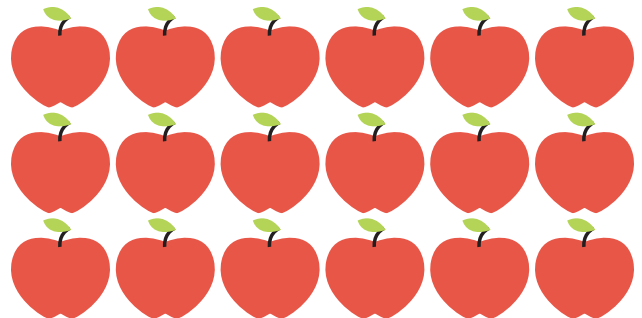

There are 15 bears. Make groups of 3.



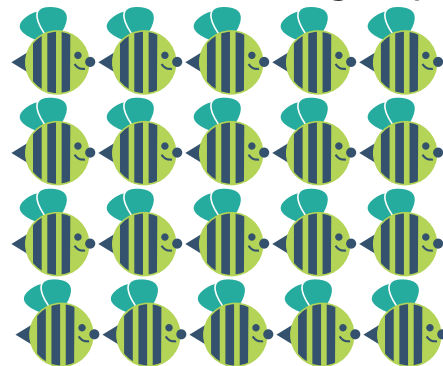
