
What is Your Ear?

Your ears are organs that help you receive and process all the sounds you hear. They also help to keep you in balance. Your ear has three sections: the *outer ear*, *middle ear* and *inner ear*.



Outer ear: collects all the sounds you hear.

Middle ear: turns the sounds of the outer ear into vib-

rations and sends them to the inner ear.

Inner ear: helps you mantain balance. Turns the vibrations into signals your brain can understand.
