| 5.) Democracy | A native or inhabitant of a country who can exercise legal rights. |
| 6.) Electoral College | A meeting of registered voters of a political party to nominate candidates and discuss issues. |
| 7.) Exit Poll | An organized course of action towards a goal. |
| 8.) General Elections | A government elected by the people. |
