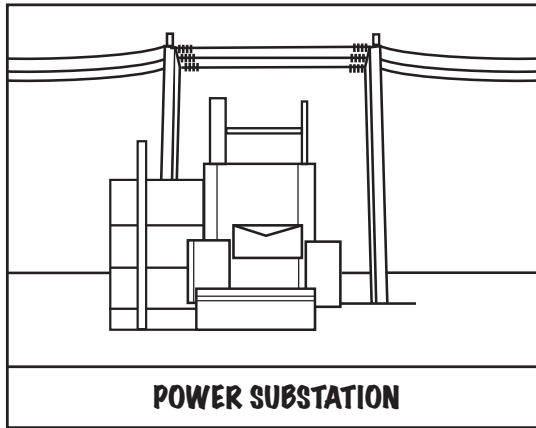
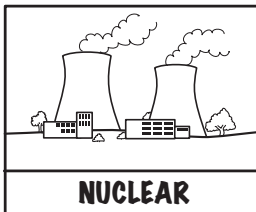
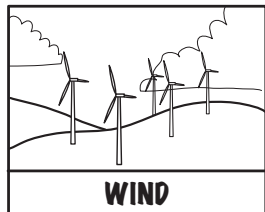
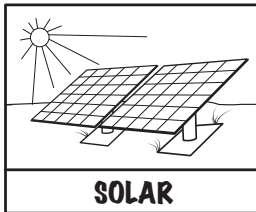
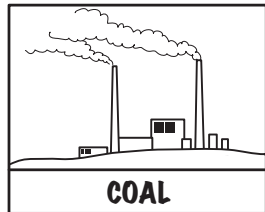


Where does electricity come from, and how do you use it?
