Elk

Elk are one of the largest kinds of deer in the world. Native Americans call them wapiti, which means "light-colored deer." Male elk shed their antlers in late winter, but grow them back again by the spring.

Directions:

1. Cut out the elk's head on page 1 along the dotted line.
2. Cut out the two paper strips on this page, along the dotted line.
3. Tape the ends of the paper strips to each side of the elk head cutout where the tabs say, "tape here."
4. Hold the headband up to your forehead and adjust the strips to fit around your head, and then tape them together.
