

Elk

Elk are one of the largest kinds of deer in the world. Native Americans call them wapiti, which means "light-colored deer." Male elk shed their antlers in late winter, but grow them back again by the spring.

Directions:

- 1. Cut out the elk's head on page 1 along the dotted line.
- 2. Cut out the two paper strips on this page, along the dotted line.
- 3. Tape the ends of the paper strips to each side of the elk head cutout where the tabs say, "tape here."
- 4. Hold the headband up to your forehead and adjust the strips to fit around your head, and then tape them together.
