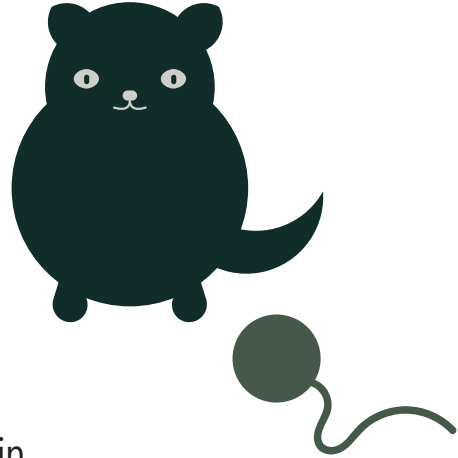


REMINDER CARDS

Ending Marks



Ending marks always belong at the end of a sentence.
There are three types of sentences.

1. Declarative Sentences tell you who is doing what.
2. Interrogative Sentences ask a question.
3. Exclamatory Sentences express surprise, anger, or pain.

Declarative Sentences

Use a period.
Tell us who is doing what.

Interrogative Sentences

Use a question mark.
Ask a question.

Exclamatory Sentences

Use an exclamation point.
Express surprise,
anger, or pain.
