

## FIND THE BATTING AVERAGE

**Directions:** Add up the batting totals for the baseball team to find each player's batting average.

**Example:** Todd went 2-for-4 at Saturday's game. That means he came up to bat four times and got two hits. He went 1-for-3 on Sunday. Separate his total hits from his total at-bats, then add.


Hits 
$$(2+1) = 3$$
  
At-Bats  $(4+3) = 7$ 

To find Todd's average, divide his total times at bat by his total number of hits:

$$3 \div 7 = 0.4285$$

Round to three decimal places, and you've got his average:

**0.429** (In baseball, you say "four twenty-nine.")



- 1. On Saturday, Johnny came up five times and got one hit. On Sunday, he came up four times and got two hits.
- 2. Darnell was 2-for-5 on Saturday and 3-for-4 on Sunday.
- **3.** Brandon got three base hits this weekend. In each game, he came to bat four times.
