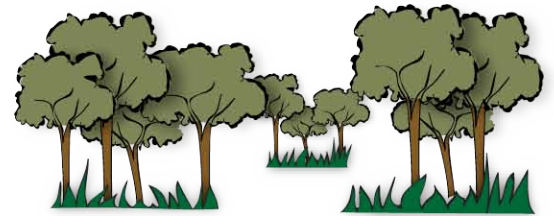


# A Walk Through the Forest
