First Person Narration	Third Person Narration	
When the story is being told from the point of view or perspective of a character who is in the story.	When the story is being told from someone else's point of view or perspective.	
Pronouns such as <b>I, me, we, us, my, our, myself, ourselves</b> show first person narration.	Pronouns such as <b>he, she, her, him, it, they,</b> <b>them, their, themselves</b> show third person narration.	
Example: <i>I knew I was in trouble when I saw my mom's face</i> .	Example: Shannon knew she was in trouble when she saw her mom's face.
