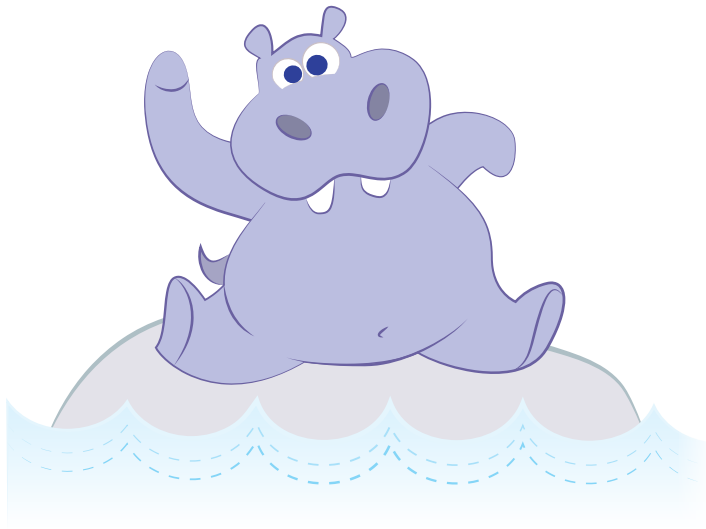


# Make an Airplane Buddy!

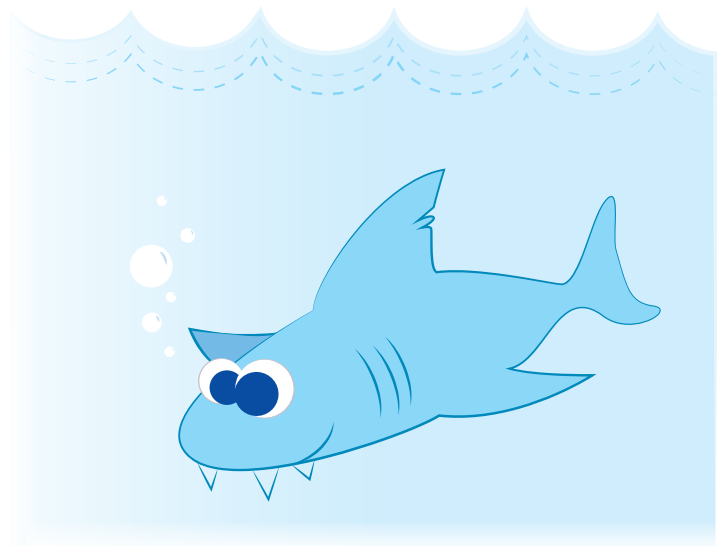


## Hippo Fun Facts:

Hippos spend most of their lives in water.

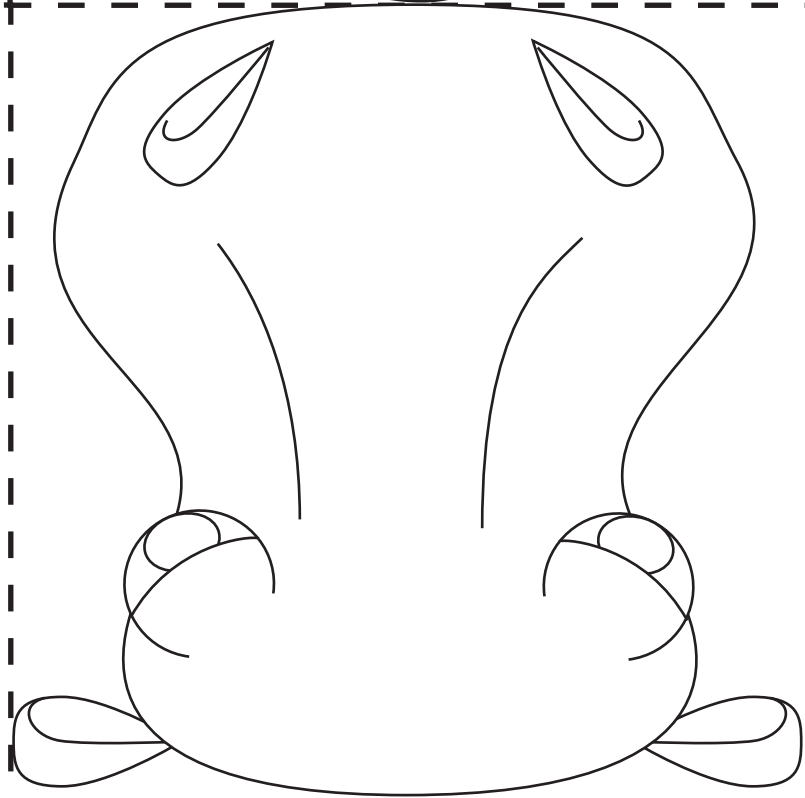
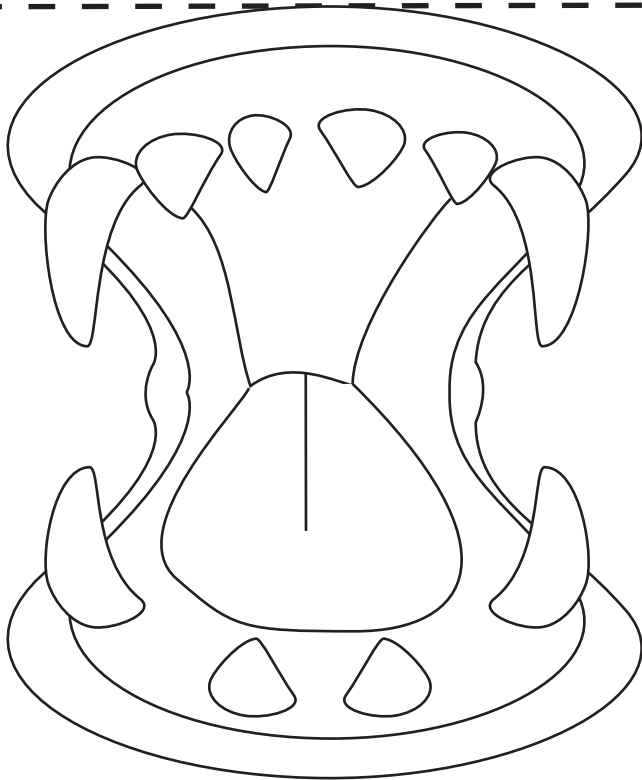
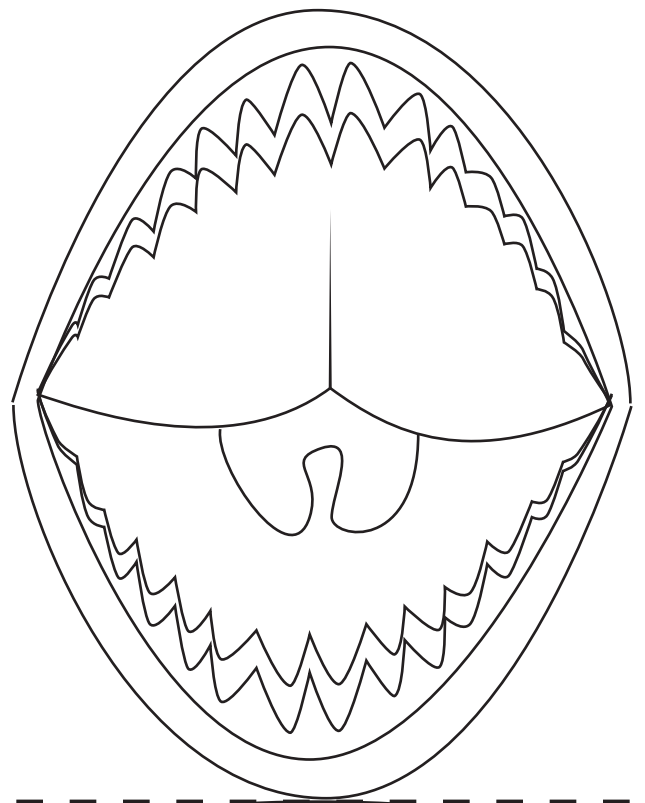
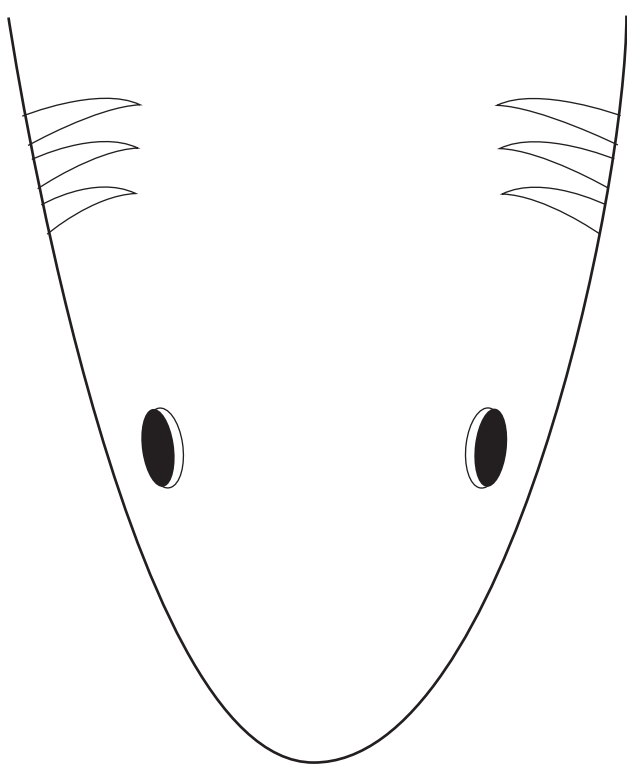


## Shark Fun Facts:
