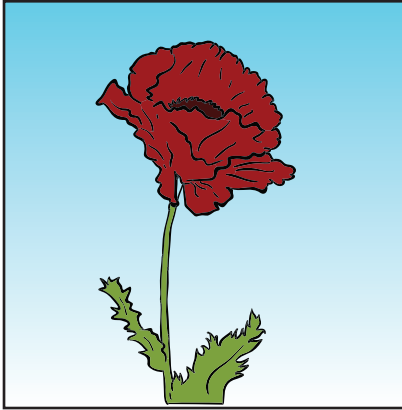
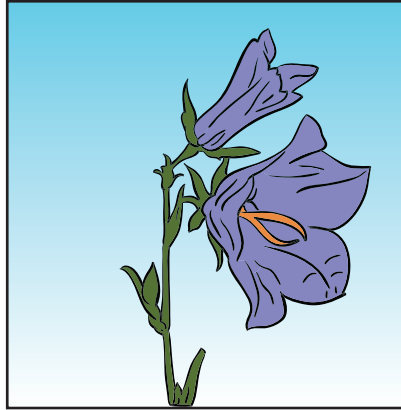


Flower Identification Chart

This is the state flower of California.



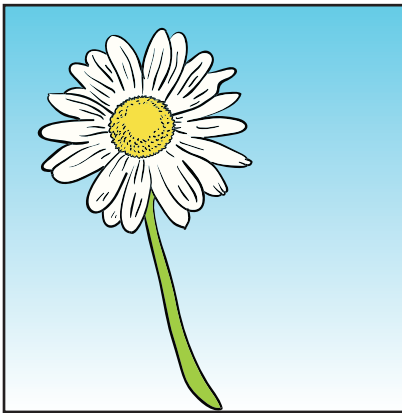
Bluebell

This purple flower hangs like a bell.



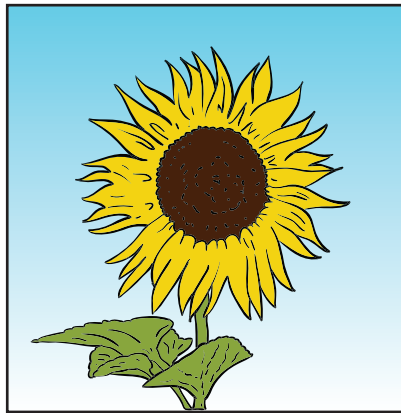
Dandelion

This flower's name means lion's tooth.



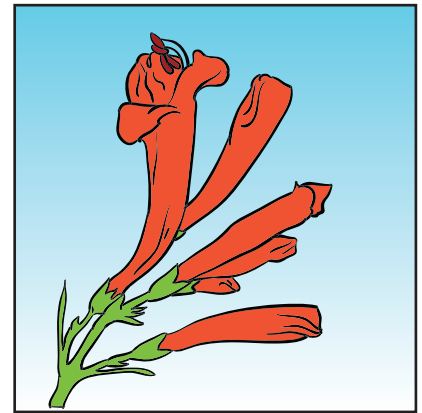
Daisy

Sunflower

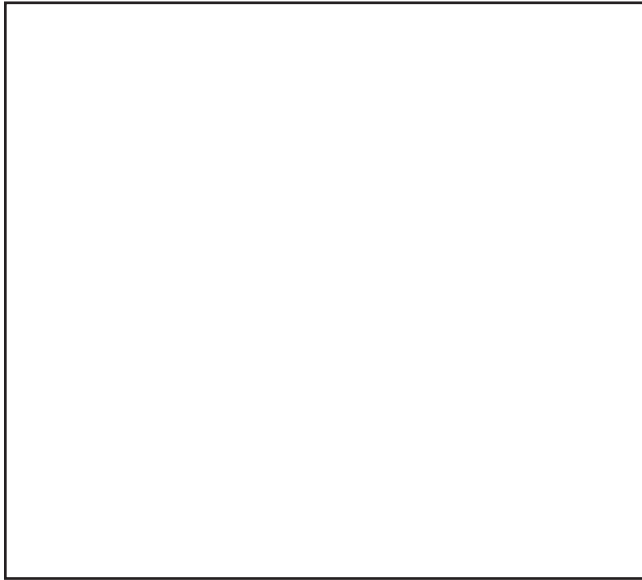
The sunflower's bloom looks like the sun.



Honeysuckle

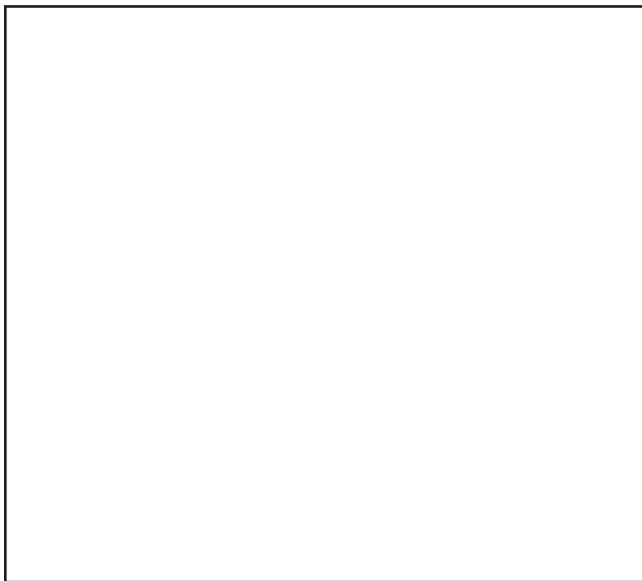
Many honeysuckles have a sweet smell. They are bell shaped and make a nectar that you can eat.

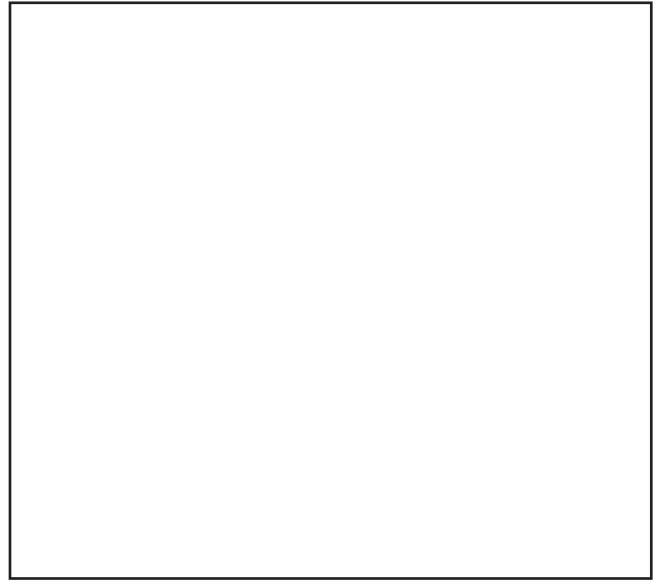

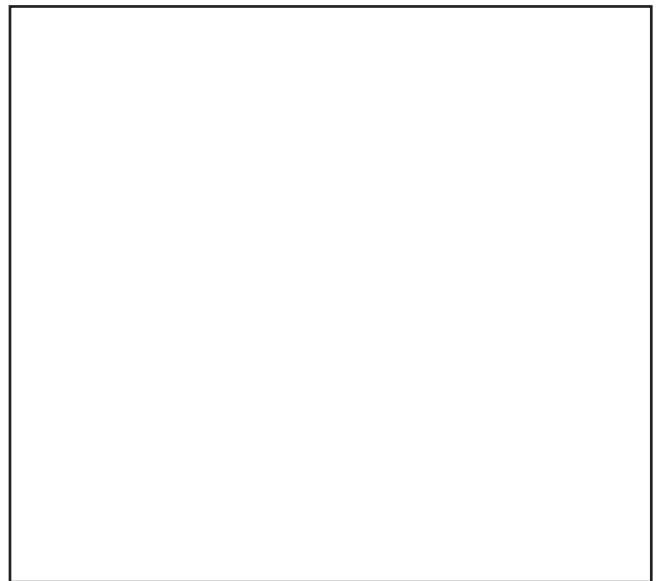
