
FRACTION BASICS:

Converting Fractions and Decimals



Fractions and decimals both represent parts of wholes. You can convert between fractions and decimals. Look at the examples below to see how. Think about place value charts to help you!

Converting Fractions to Decimals

Convert $\frac{1}{10}$ to a decimal.

 $\frac{1}{10}$ is 1 out of 10, or one tenth:

ones		tenths
0		1

$$\frac{1}{10} = 0.1$$

Converting Decimals to Fractions

Convert 0.8 to a fraction.

0.8 is the same as eight tenths:

ones		tenths
0		8

$$0.8 = \frac{8}{10}$$

Convert $\frac{53}{100}$ to a decimal.

 $\frac{53}{100}$ is 53 out of 100, or fifty-three hundredths:

ones	tenths	hundredths
0	5	3

$$\frac{53}{100} = 0.53$$

Convert 0.72 to a fraction.

0.72 is the same as seventy-two hundredths:

ones	tenths	hundredths
0	7	2

$$0.72 = \frac{72}{100}$$
