The Freedom Trail

Boston National Historical Park, also called The Freedom Trail, is a collection of historic sites related to famous events leading up to the American Revolution. The 2.5 mile walk through Boston's historic downtown passes by sites like The Old North Church, The Old South Meeting House, the Paul Revere House, and across the river to the Bunker Hill Monument in Charlestown.
