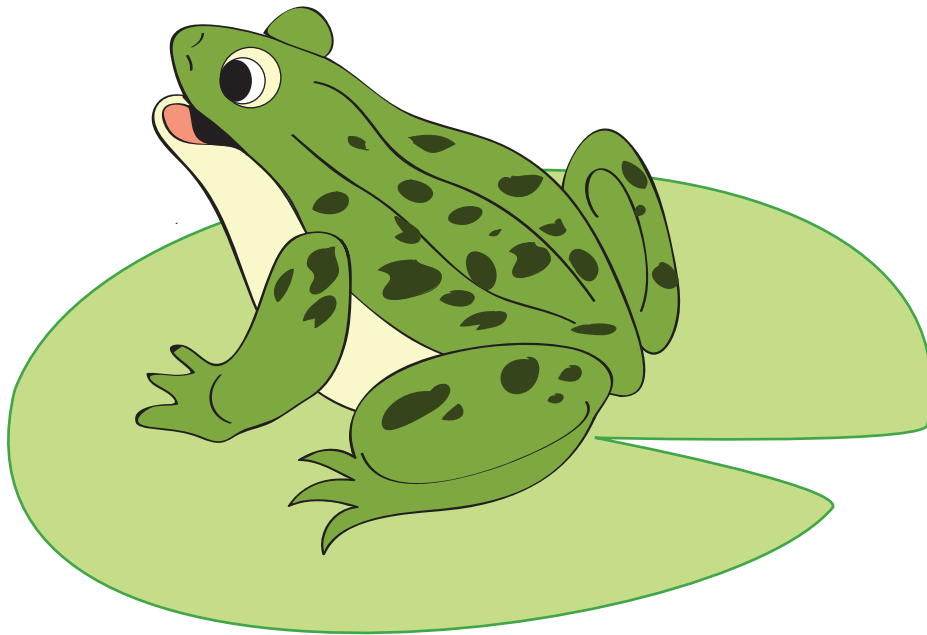


How Does a Frog Drink Water?

Strange Facts: Frog with No Lungs!

The first known species of a frog that breathes without lungs was found in Indonesia. This lungless frog, *Barbourula kalimantanensis*, seems to get all of its necessary oxygen through its skin.
