

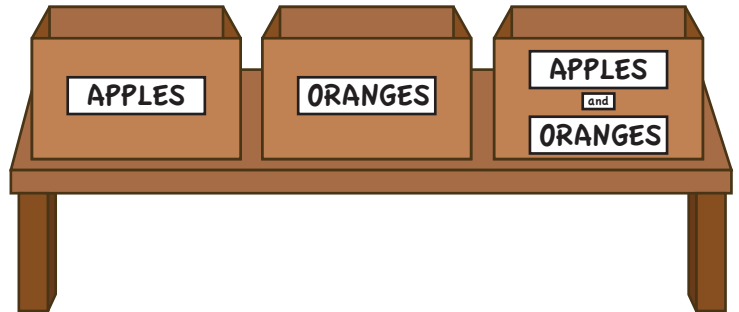
Mathematical Mindbenders!
