Use farther to talk about physical distance, like miles.
Use further to show "metaphorical" distance that has passed, like time.

1. Her house is a little (further/farther) up the road.

2. If this silliness goes any (further/farther) I'm going to turn this car around!

3. I can't go on any (further/farther) not knowing how I did on that test.

4. The rousing speech he gave on Monday only (furthered/farthered) his chances of winning.
