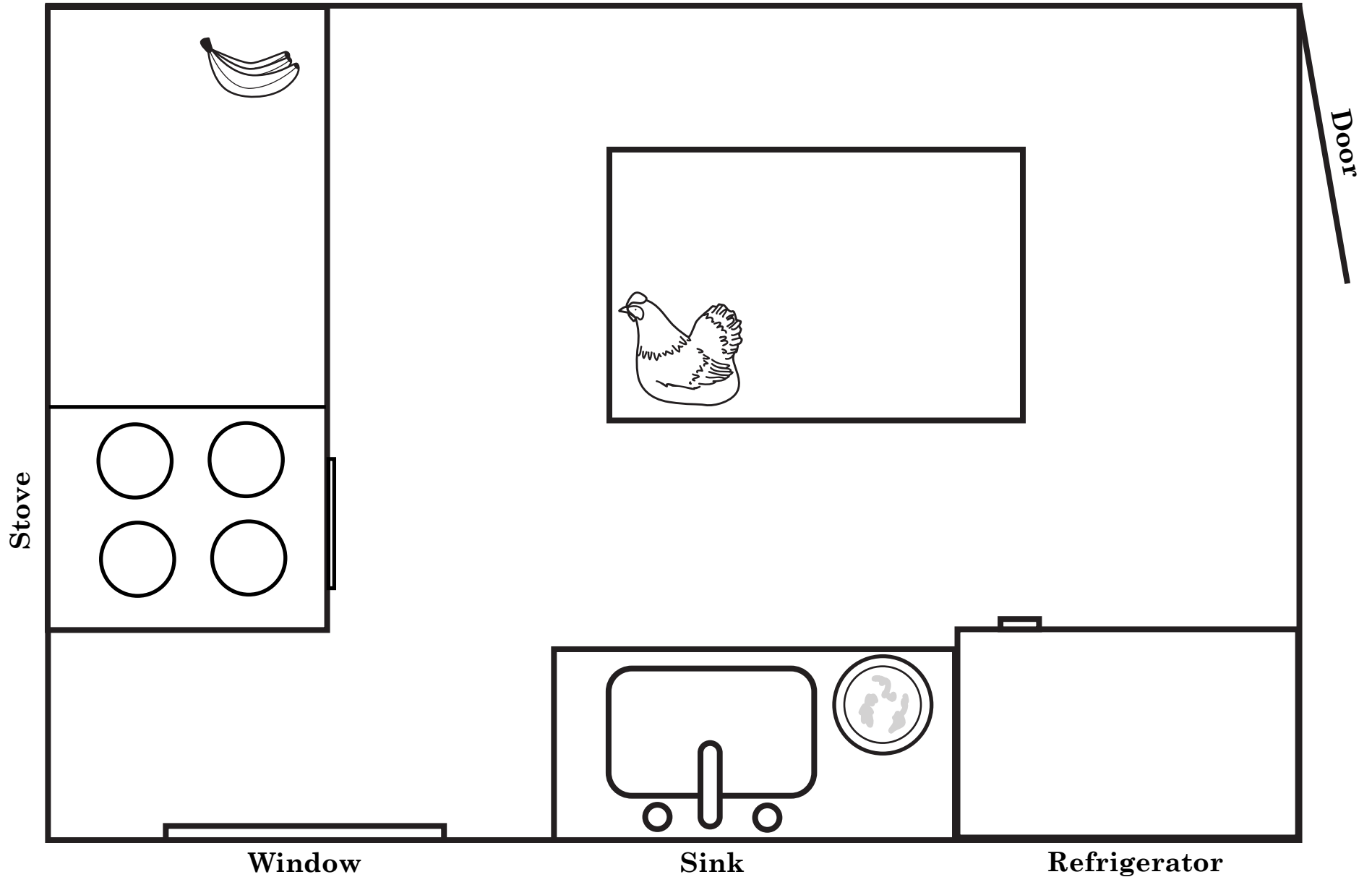


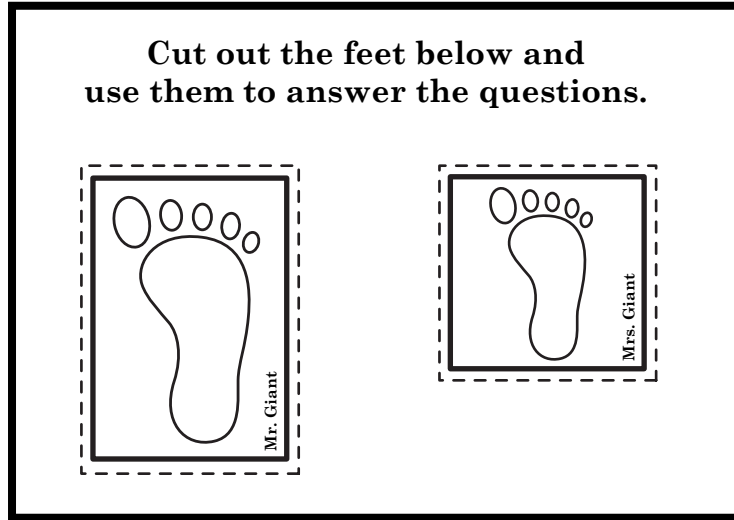
# Irregular Measurements
