Word	Definition	Visual	
relieved	The feeling of not having the pain or worry that you had before.		
anxious	Feeling worried, nervous, or afraid about something uncertain.		
doubtful	A feeling of not being certain or sure.		
ecstatic	In a condition of extreme delight.		
puzzled	Unable to understand something or the reason for something.		
terrified	Filled with great fear or terror.

Word	Definition	Visual	
regretful	Having sorrow or remorse for a loss, an act, or a disappointment.		
embarrassed	Feeling uncomfortable because of shame or receiving too much attention from others.
