



hesitant	(adj.) Someone who is not feeling sure.		
perseverance	(n) A constant continuance in a course of action, task, or belief.		
determined	(adj.) Someone who decides to do something and tries over and over to complete it.		
anxious	(adj.) Feeling worried, nervous, or afraid about something uncertain.		
patient	(adj.) Someone able to stay calm when faced with pain, trouble, or a long wait.		
feelings	(n) An emotion, like happiness or sadness.
