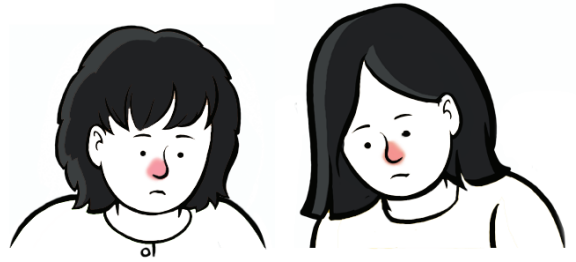


Plural Possessive Nouns

A possessive noun shows ownership.

A **plural possessive noun** that ends in **s** is made by adding an **apostrophe (')** at its end.
