

Green Tree Frogs

Habitat: swamps, marshes, and weedy areas of lakes and ponds of southern USA and Australia

Size: 2½ inches long

Lifespan: 2-5 years

Eats: insects



Green tree frogs are nocturnal. During the day, they sleep attached to the underside of leaves.

They prefer to walk rather than jump, but can jump high into trees if threatened.

They vary from yellow-olive to lime green, often with a white stripe from their mouth to their back leg. They can change color slightly depending on temperature and light.
