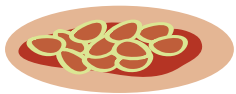
Words that sound the same but have different meanings and spellings are "homophones". For each sentence, choose the right homophone and write it down in the space provided.

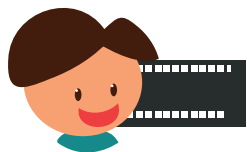
