

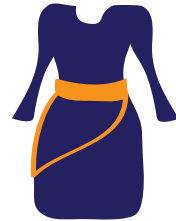
Buy, By, Bye

- Bye is short for "goodbye."

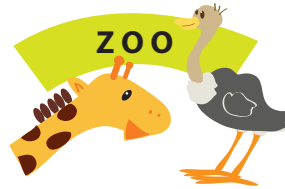

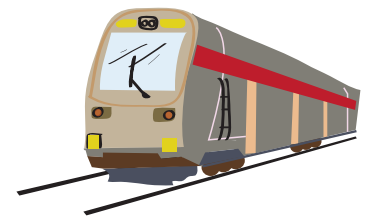
