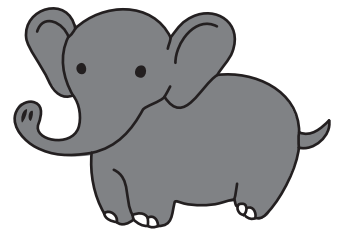
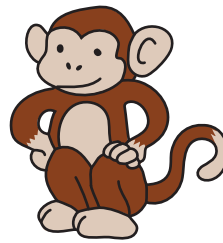
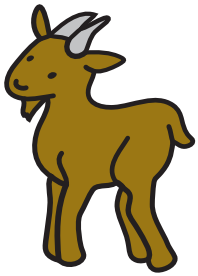


Guessing Practice

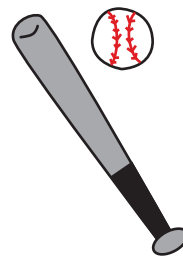
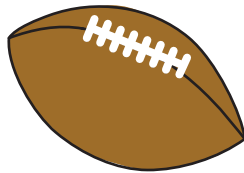
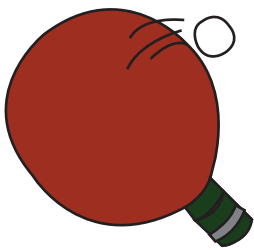
Playing guessing games will help your child start to learn how to make educated guesses and use process of elimination in a test-taking setting.
