

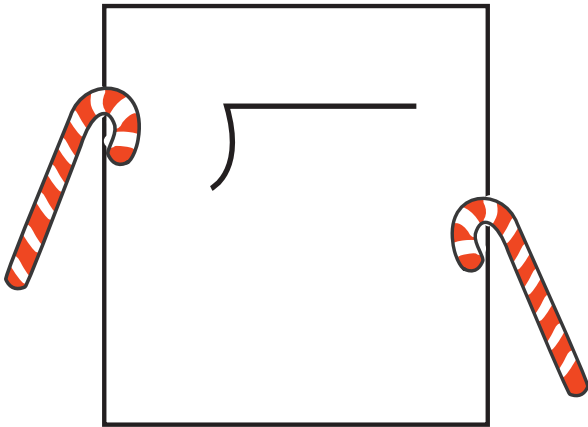
# Candy Math

Its Halloween next month and mom bought lots of candy to give out. She has asked us to find out the price of each candy. Can you help us with the math?

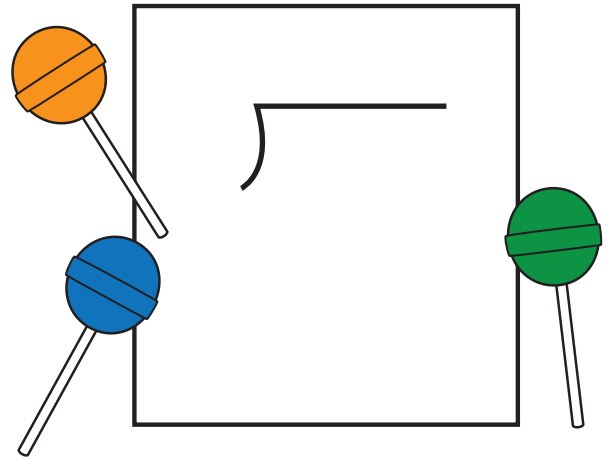

How much does 1 candy cane cost?



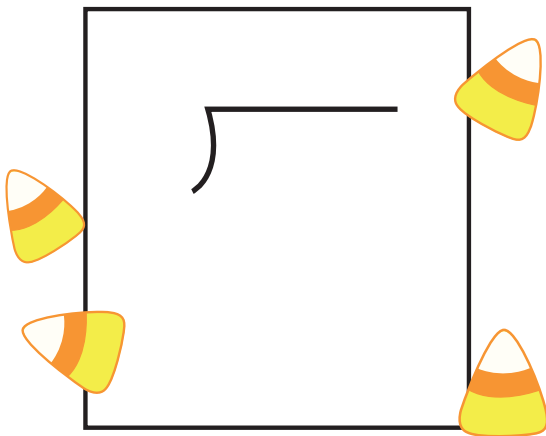
Cost of 1 candy cane = \_\_\_\_\_

Jane had asked for lollypops, so mom bought 10 of them for 80 cents. How much does one cost?



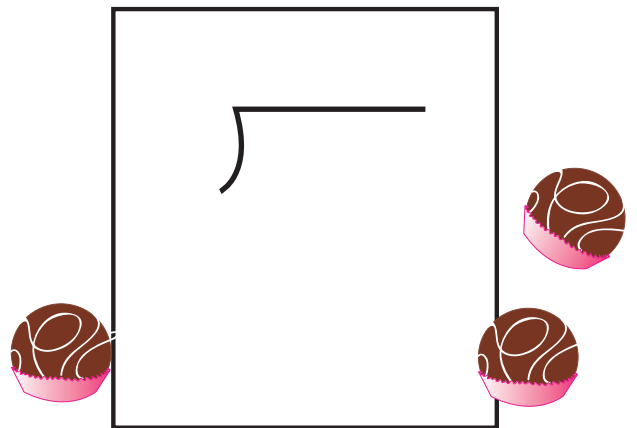
Cost of 1 lollypop = \_\_\_\_\_
