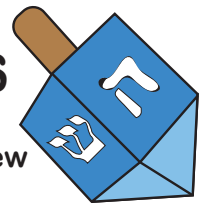


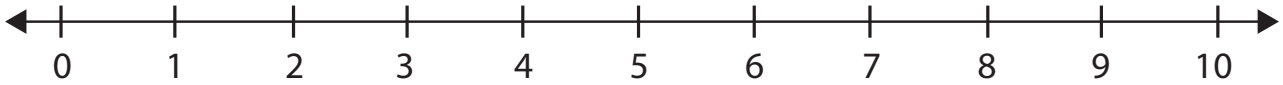


Hanukkah Number Line Problems

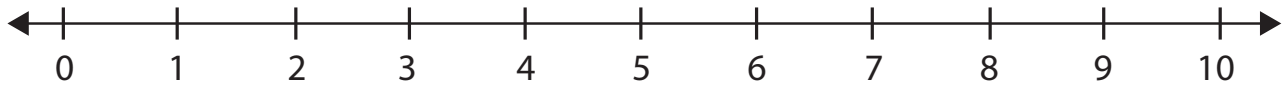
Jake won 10 candies but he had to put 7 back in the pot. How many does he have left?

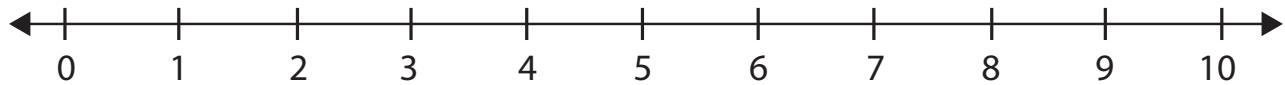
Sheela won 8 candies but had to put 3 back in the pot. How many does she have left?



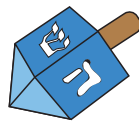

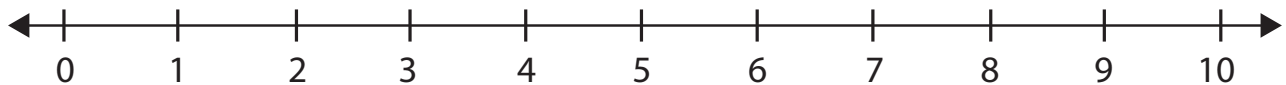
Ciara won 9 candies pretty fast in the game, but had to put 5 back in the pot. How many does she have left?
