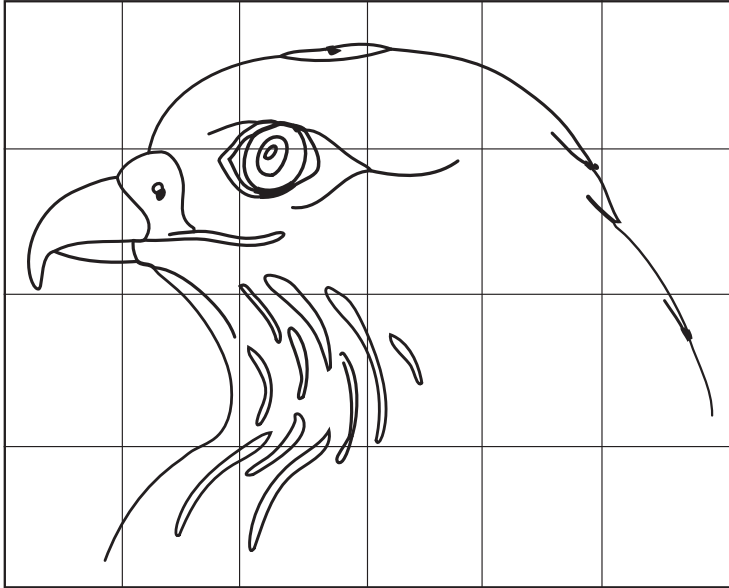


# Harris Hawk

- The Harris hawk builds its nests in trees 30 to 40 feet above the ground.
- Harris hawks are common in Mexico, southern Texas and Arizona.
