

Head to Head Fiction: Problems and Solutions

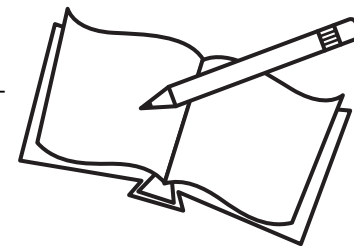

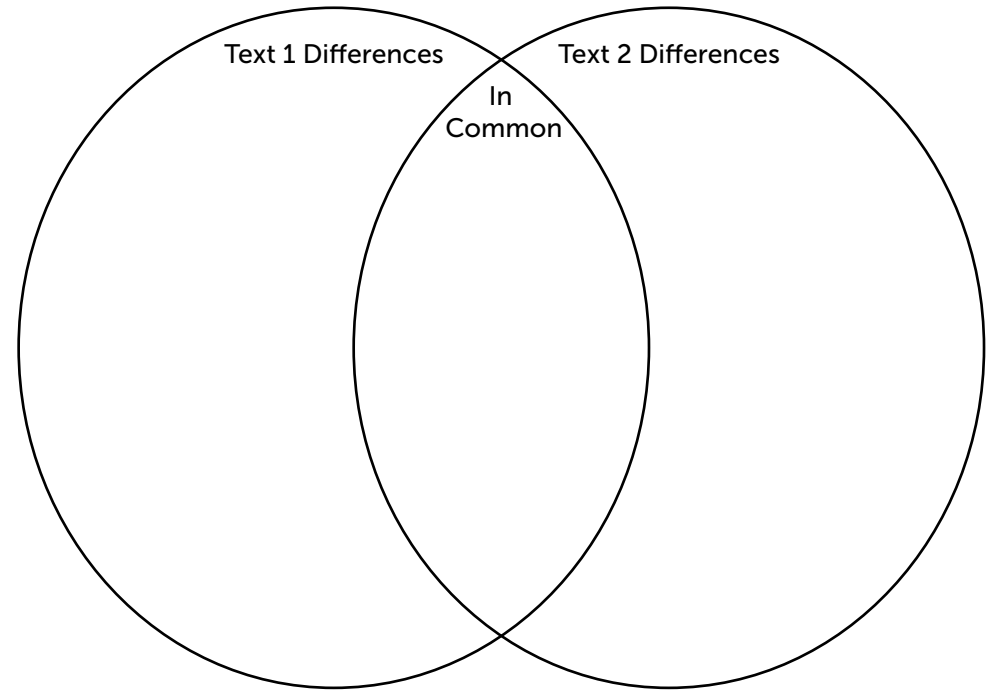
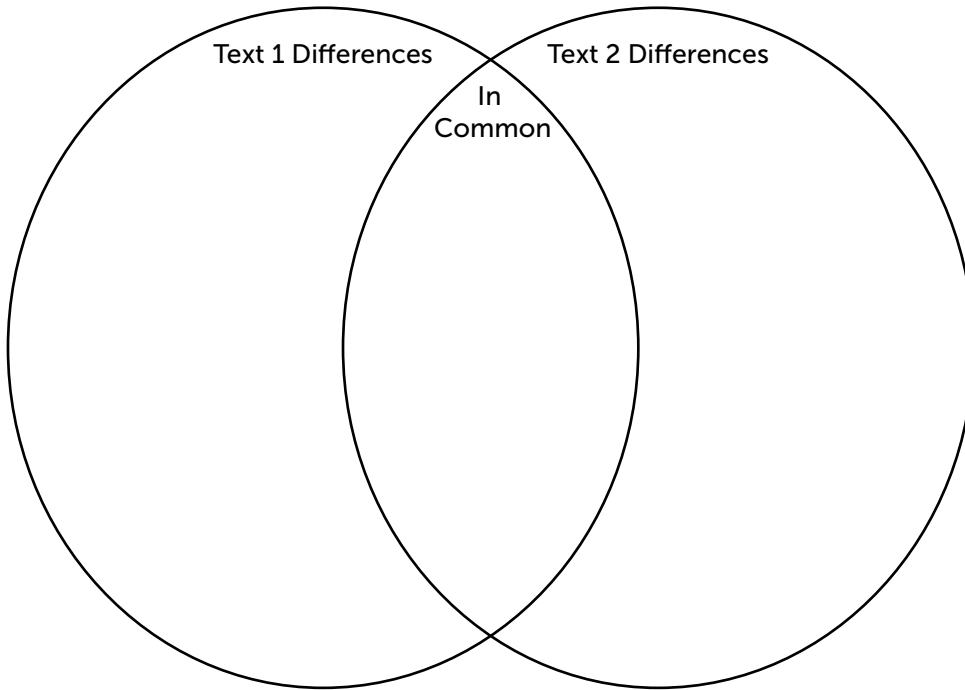
