

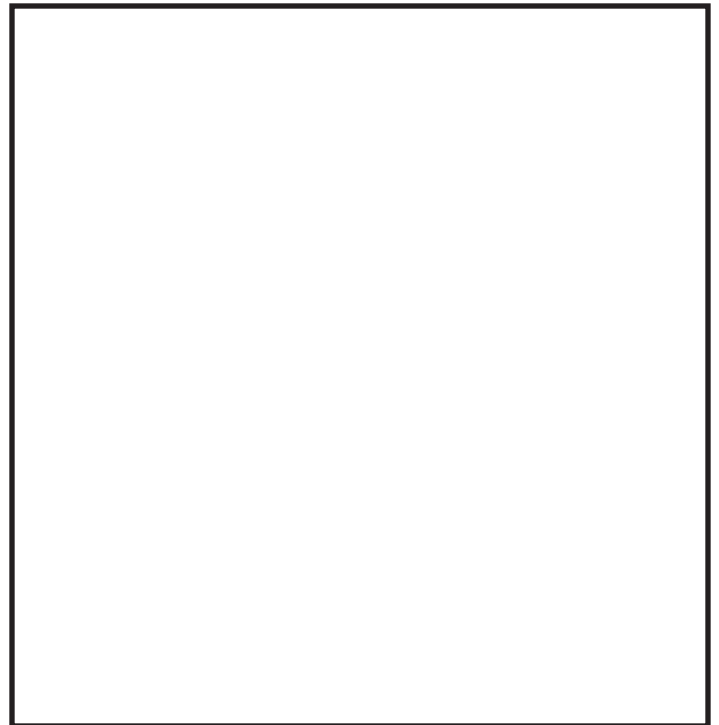
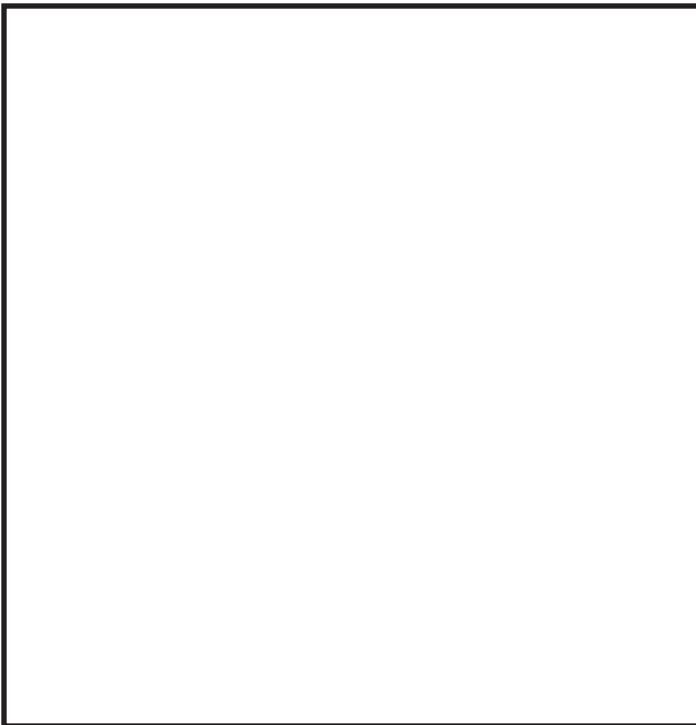
HOMOPHONES #1
