

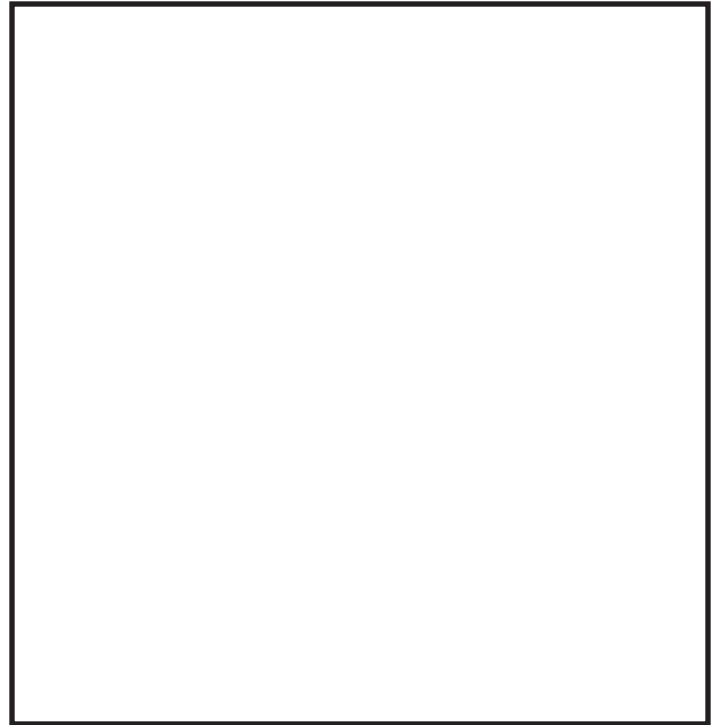
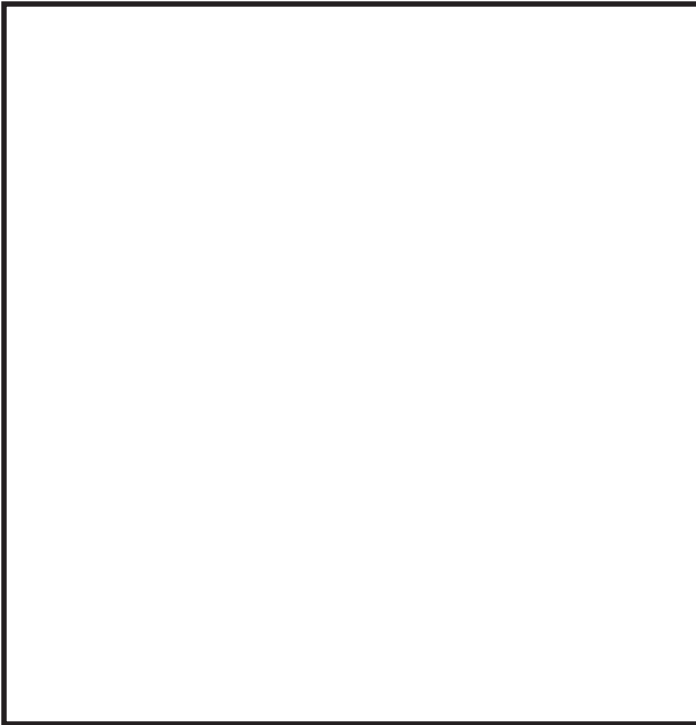
HOMOPHONES #3
