

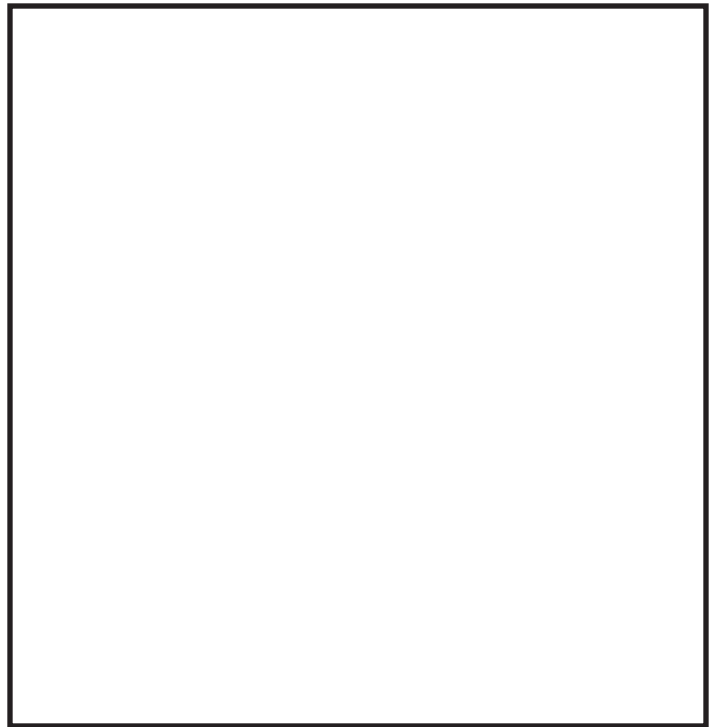
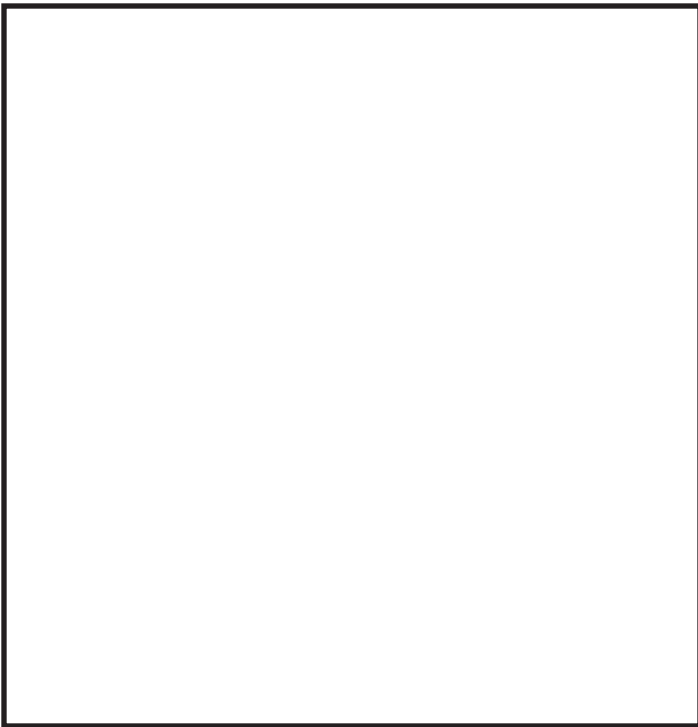
HOMOPHONES #5
