

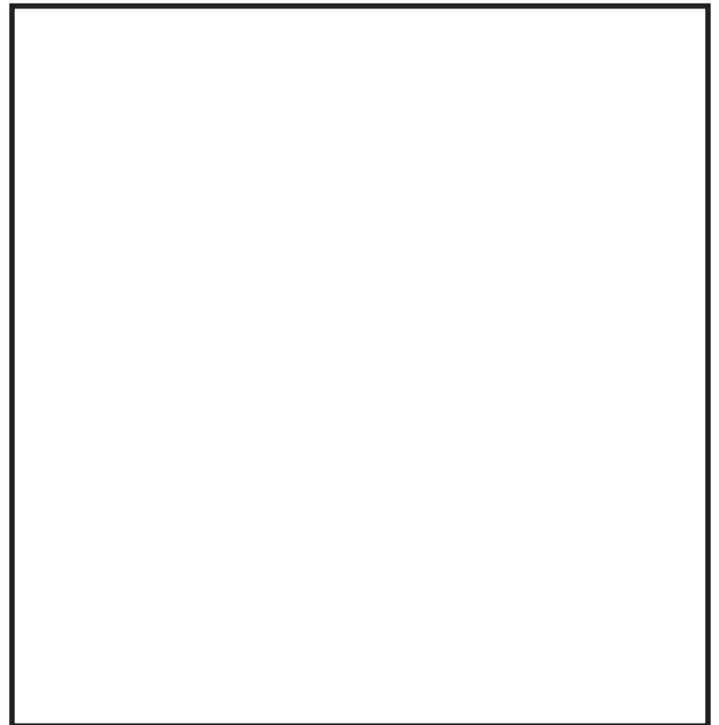
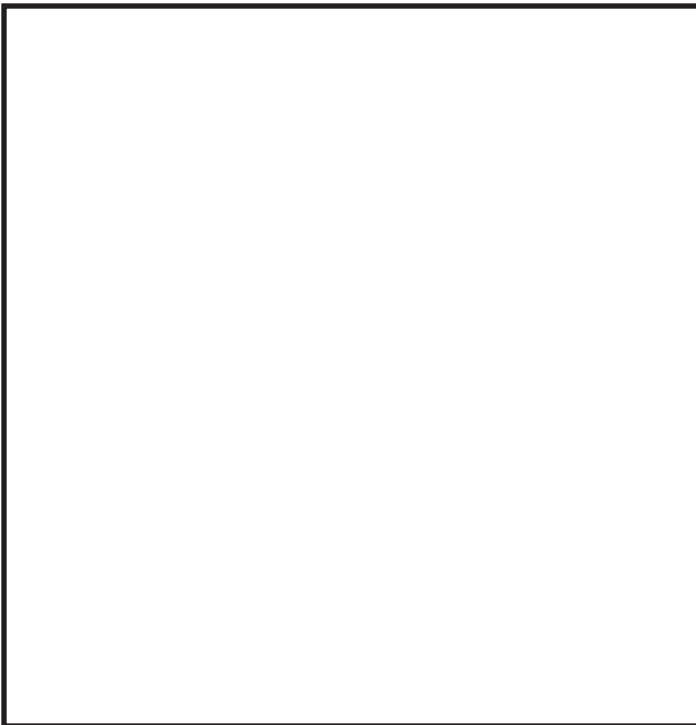
HOMOPHONES #9
